# What's Changing for 2026?

- **Starting January 1, 2026**, the WV PEIA Group Medicare Advantage and Prescription Drug Plans with Humana will be administered as **two separate plans**, rather than being combined into one.
- The medical and pharmacy coverage will be provided separately. This means you will receive **two new Humana ID cards in the mail**.
- Starting January 1, 2026, give your new medical plan ID card to medical providers and your new prescription plan ID card to network pharmacies. These cards will arrive separately in the mail.
- You will receive **2 confirmations of enrollment** one for medical, one for pharmacy and some other duplicated CMS-required notices. Mailings will arrive at different times.






### What is a PPO?

Humana's a Preferred Provider Organization (PPO)

#### **Preferred Provider Organization**

Choose any provider that accepts Medicare and agrees to bill the plan.

- With your PPO plan, you will pay the same amount for both in- and out-of-network for care
- Most preventative care is covered at 100%
- Out-of-pocket maximum for covered medical services
- Worldwide emergency coverage



**Note**: All new and existing Humana members will receive a **new Medical Humana ID card** in December and will need to give that card to **your medical providers** as of Jan. 1, 2026.



## What is Medicare?

Different "parts" of Medicare pay for different types of coverage.



#### **Medicare Part A**

Hospital insurance

It helps cover medically necessary inpatient care in a hospital or skilled nursing facility. It also helps cover some home healthcare and hospice care.



#### **Medicare Part B**

Medical insurance

It helps cover medically necessary providers' services, outpatient care and other medical services and supplies. Part B also helps cover some preventive services.



#### **Medicare Part C**

Medicare Advantage plans

These are available through private insurance companies, such as Humana. Medicare Part C helps cover everything medically necessary that Part A and Part B cover, including hospital and medical services. You still have Medicare if you elect Medicare Part C coverage. You must be entitled to Medicare Part A and enrolled in Part B to be eligible for a Medicare Part C plan.



#### **Medicare Part D**

Prescription drug coverage

It helps pay for the medications your provider prescribes and is available in a standalone prescription drug plan or included in a Medicare Advantage prescription drug plan. Like Part C Medicare Advantage plans, Part D is only available through private companies, such as Humana. Many Part C Medicare Advantage plans include Medicare Part D prescription drug coverage.



# **Prescription Drug Plan (PDP)**

- Generic, brand and specialty drug coverage
- Access to retail pharmacies
- Member cost share of the Humana plan's covered insulin products covered under Part B and Part D is no more than \$35 for every one-month (up to a 30day) supply.
- \$0 copay for all Part D vaccines listed on the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) list†.



**Note**: All new and existing Humana members will receive a **new Prescription Humana ID card** in December and will need to give that card to **your pharmacy** as of Jan. 1, 2026.

### **Medicare Part D**

Humana's Part D coverage is designed to help you manage your out-of-pocket costs.

#### **Annual Deductible**

#### **Initial Coverage**

#### **Maximum out-of-pocket**

#### STAGE 1

#### **Deductible**

You pay full cost of your drugs until you meet the deductible.

#### STAGE 2

#### **Initial coverage**

Your plan gives you coverage for your drugs, up to the catastrophic coverage.

#### STAGE 3

#### Maximum out-of-pocket

The most you'll spend before your plan pays 100% of the cost.

The most you would have to pay for Prescriptions covered by a health plan, including deductibles, copays and coinsurance. Once your annual out-of-pocket limit has been reached, the Humana Group Medicare plan pays 100% for most pharmacy charges.



# Part B vs. Part D coverage



#### **Part B - Medical Benefits**

- Injectable/IV drugs given in provider's office
- Diabetic testing supplies, insulin pumps, insulin for insulin pump and CGMs
- Commonly used nebulized medications
- Vaccines such as influenza, pneumococcal, and COVID-19 vaccine & boosters

#### **Part D - Pharmacy Benefits**

- Covers most medications
- Diabetes medications
- Insulin administered (or used) with syringes or pens
- Syringes, pen needles or other insulin administration devices that are not durable medical equipment (e.g., Omnipod or VGO).
- Vaccines such as Shingles, Tdap, RSV

# Part D prescription drug coverage

Humana's Part D coverage portion of your plan covers vaccines that are considered necessary to help prevent illness.

#### **Vaccines at a network pharmacy**

Vaccines that you should get at your pharmacy, not from your provider's office:

- Shingles
- Tdap
- RSV

# Diabetes prescriptions and supplies covered under Part D

- Diabetes medications
- Insulin administered (or used) with syringes or pens
- Syringes, pen needles or other insulin administration devices that are not durable medical equipment (e.g., Omnipod or VGO)


