



# Risk adjustment 2025 monthly learning series July–December CME and CEU sessions

The CarePlus risk adjustment provider education team is pleased to promote the live Humana\* online learning sessions for the second six months of 2025.

**2. MRA overview** – These sessions will focus on risk adjustment as the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) payment model for Medicare Advantage (MA) plans, designed to encourage MA organizations (MAOs) to compete based on efficiencies and quality of care rather than on ability to attract healthy individuals.
