

Risk adjustment 2025 monthly learning series January–June CME and CEU sessions

- 1. The Importance of Accurate Documentation and Coding: A Physician's Perspective These sessions will focus on understanding the healthcare components related to risk adjustment and how to leverage accurate clinical documentation and coding to capture the true health status of the patient.
- **2. MRA overview** These sessions will focus on risk adjustment as the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) payment model for Medicare Advantage (MA) plans, designed to encourage MA organizations (MAOs) to compete based on efficiencies and quality of care, rather than on ability to attract healthy individuals.
