Answers to frequently asked questions about tutoring services through Tutor.com

As an extra benefit, Humana Healthy Horizons® in South Carolina members in grades K-12 can access no-cost, online tutoring services through Tutor.com that include:

- Access to academic resources
- Personalized one-on-one help with schoolwork with a live tutor skilled in the subject area
- Real-time writing help

Below you'll find answers to frequently asked questions about this extra benefit.

Q. How do I access the tutoring services?

A. Eligible Humana Healthy Horizons in South Carolina members can access services through Tutor.com. To prove eligibility, you must:

- Prove that you are a Humana Healthy Horizons in South Carolina member, such as through:
 - MyHumana.com
 - Go365 for Humana Healthy Horizons®
 - Other way

Q. How old do you have to be to set up a Tutor.com account?

A. Minors cannot set up a Tutor.com account. A minor's parent or guardian can set up an account on behalf of the minor.

Q. What services are available?

- **A.** Available services include:
- Private, one-on-one online tutoring sessions
- Support with homework
- Review of subject material(s) (See Appendix for list of core academic subjects)
- Practice sessions

Q. When are live tutors available?

A. Live tutors are available seven days a week.

Q. Can I work with the same tutor each time?

A. Tutor.com lets students schedule sessions in advance with the same tutor through a scheduling feature.

Q. How much time each week can I access a tutor through Tutor.com?

A. Humana Healthy Horizons in South Carolina members can access up to two hours each week of tutoring through Tutor.com.

Q. When during the day can I connect with a live tutor?

A. Tutor.com offers English-language and bilingual services as follows:

- English-speaking tutors who specialize in core academic subjects (see Appendix) are available 24/7
- Bilingual tutors who specialize in core academic subjects (See Appendix) are available from at least 2 p.m. – 2 a.m. seven days a week





Q. Are tutors available on federal holidays?

A. While Tutor.com has tutors available every day, availability is limited on:

- January 1
- July 4
- Thanksgiving
- December 25

Q. What if I'm not happy with the tutoring I/my child get(s)?

A. Students are asked to complete a brief satisfaction survey at the end of each tutoring session.

Q. What other support is available?

A. Tutor.com provides students with:

- Technical support via its client services and support staff during business hours
- Email support 24/7
- Access to answers to frequently asked technical questions

Q. Do I need to have a speaker built into my computer?

A. The conversation part of the tutoring session can be done over a phone, but you must have a computer screen for the tutoring portion.

Q. What are the technical requirements to access services through Tutor.com?

Q. Do I need to access tutoring via a desktop device only?

A. Tutor.com has an app available for iOS and Android, but you must:

- Set up an account via the desktop version
- Download the app to a mobile device
- Access your custom account via the app

Q. What type of Internet connection should I have?

A. Tutor.com recommends an Internet connection with a minimum speed of 56K.
