### What is the program?

The Building Bridges of Understanding Program is a 5-Hour Self-Paced Continuing Education Course. Upon completion, providers will earn 5 AMA PRA Category 1 Credits.

### What are the learning objectives?

Learn to provide evidenced-based assessment and treatment of anxiety, depression, and ADHD within the primary care setting.

### What is the cost to participate?

The program is offered free of charge to providers working in Florida through funding provided by Rotary International.
