



Drug Recall Notice for Cetirizine Hydrochloride Tablets USP 5 mg

As part of Humana's commitment to your health and safety, we are sharing important information about your medicine with you. You are receiving this letter because you were identified as having a recent prescription for a drug that is being recalled.

Below is more information on the medication.

Drug Name: Cetirizine Hydrochloride Tablets USP 5 mg

Reason for withdrawal: Due to cross contamination with Ranitidine.

What This Means for You:

- To determine if your medication is affected, you should look at the drug name and company name on the label of your prescription. If the information is not on the bottle, you should contact the pharmacy that dispensed the medication.
- If you are not taking Cetirizine Hydrochloride Tablets USP 5 mg or if your doctor has already told you to stop, you do not need to do anything.
