Subject: Dental services in an ambulatory surgical center and scheduled outpatient hospital settings billing guidance

Effective Oct. 1, 2025, under the Statewide Medicaid Managed Care (SMMC) contracts, medical plans must now reimburse nonemergency outpatient dental anesthesia services performed in an ambulatory surgical center (ASC) and other outpatient settings.

Medical plans are now required to reimburse for the coverage of anesthesiology services when provided in conjunction with covered dental services. This does not include reimbursing local dentists with hospital privileges who are performing services in an ASC setting or outpatient setting. Services performed by a dentist will continue to be reimbursed by dental plans, including sedation dentistry services referred to an ASC. Reimbursements made by medical plans include payments to the facility as well as payment for ancillary services. Medical plans will reimburse anesthesiologist services rendered, including any anesthesiology services provided in an office setting when medically necessary.

Health and dental plans are required to ensure continuity of care during the transition period for Medicaid recipients enrolled in the SMMC program. For at least sixty (60) days following the transition, medical managed care plans must honor any appointments and procedures scheduled prior to Oct. 1, 2025, and reimburse non-participating providers at the rate they received prior to the transition date unless the provider agrees to an alternative rate.
