



# Humana Healthy Horizons in Florida Expanded Benefits Provider Resource Guide

**Welcome to Humana Healthy Horizons® in Florida, a Medicaid managed care program focused on helping members achieve their best health. This provider resource guide lists all expanded benefits offered to Humana Healthy Horizons members.**

Expanded benefits are those services offered by Humana Healthy Horizons and approved in writing by the Florida Agency for Health Care Administration (AHCA). Such expanded benefits are those services or benefits not otherwise covered or that exceed limits outlined in the Medicaid state plan handbook, the Florida Medicaid coverage and limitations handbooks, and Florida Medicaid fee schedules. In instances where an expanded benefit is also a Medicaid covered service, Humana Healthy Horizons will administer the benefit in accordance with any applicable service standards, the Florida Medicaid state plan, and any Medicaid coverage and limitations.

If copayments are waived as an expanded benefit, the provider must not charge member copayments for covered services. If copayments are not waived as an expanded benefit, the amount paid to providers shall be the contracted amount for fee-for-service managed care plans, the Medicaid fee schedule amount, less any applicable copayments.

Excludes members’ parents and guardians who have their own means of transportation.</p> <p>Members pay nothing.</p>
<b>NMT for social needs</b>	<p>Members ages 18 and older, up to 6 round trips (12, 1-way trips) up to 30 miles for NMT per year to locations such as job/vocational training, social support groups, wellness classes, Women, Infants and Children (WIC) and Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) appointments, and food banks</p> <p>This benefit also offers transportation to locations providing social benefits and community integration for members, such as community and neighborhood centers, parks, recreation areas, and churches.</p> <p>Members pay nothing.</p>
<b>Nursing facility transition assistance</b>	<p>Humana Healthy Horizons offers a nursing facility transition benefit to help the family of a child living in a nursing facility to bring their child home. The benefit will provide assistance to the child and their family to help overcome barriers preventing the child from living at home. This benefit is available for individuals who are currently residing in a nursing facility and are either younger than 21 years old or under 30 years old and have been living in a nursing facility before turning 21 years old. The nursing facility transition benefit may include the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Home renovations</li> <li>• Purchase of a generator to provide power to medical equipment during outages</li> <li>• Home additions to give the child space for all necessary medical equipment and care needs</li> </ul>

<b>Over-the-counter (OTC) medications and supplies</b>	<p>\$50 per month allowance enables households to support commonly occurring conditions by purchasing products such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pain relievers</li> <li>• Diaper rash cream</li> <li>• Cough and cold relief medicine</li> <li>• First aid equipment that does not require a prescription</li> </ul> <p>Unused amounts do not roll over to the next month.</p> <p>Members pay nothing.</p>
