How much do annual exams cost?	Your annual eye exam cost is \$10
What is my glasses frame allowance?	\$125 wholesale allowance
What's the difference between "wholesale" price and "retail" price for frames?	The wholesale price is the price the retailer paid for the frames and not the price they mark them up to for retail sale. This means your wholesale allowance stretches farther.
What does the \$150 contact lens allowance cover?	The allowance covers your contact lens fitting, follow-up and contact lenses.
Do I have coverage for progressive and other lens options?	Yes, you have coverage after a copay, or the amount you pay, for standard and premium progressive lenses, UV protection and anti-reflective coatings.
