 - Resources for substance abuse or mental health concerns
 - Support and education during and after a pregnancy
 - Support for your treatment plan, for patients with high-risk pregnancies

We are committed to improving timeliness of prenatal care and adherence to postpartum and well-child care. Please contact HumanaBeginnings care management program if your patient stops attending prenatal visits. We may be able to help.

Behavioral health

Our behavioral health vendors can coordinate services for members who need mental health care and/or substance use intervention(s). The American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists (ACOG) recommends screening for substance use early in pregnancy and at the first prenatal visit, as part of comprehensive obstetric care.

Breast pumps

Breast pumps are a covered benefit for new mothers. Eligible enrollees can get a free breast pump after their OB-GYN submits orders to a durable medical equipment provider.

Doula services

Enrollees can receive doula assistance for emotional and physical support during and after pregnancy. Covered assistance includes two prenatal visits, two postpartum visits, and one visit for delivery assistance.

Free portable crib

Enrollees who participate in HumanaBeginnings care management program and attend six prenatal visits will earn a free portable crib.

Go365 for Humana Healthy Horizons

Go365 for Humana Healthy Horizons[®] is a wellness program that offers rewards to enrollees who take healthy actions. For HumanaBeginnings enrollees, these actions include having prenatal, postpartum and well-child visits.

Post-discharge meals

We coordinate the delivery of meals to enrollees' homes after delivery.

Transportation

We cover transportation for enrollees:

- During emergencies
- For non-emergency, non-ambulatory stretcher services

Kentucky Medicaid may pay for transportation for non-emergency medical care. Enrollees can call **888-941-7433** to get help from the closest transportation service.

Community connections

The HumanaBeginnings care management team coordinates with our social determinants of health team to help address health disparities and barriers to transportation and other resources. We can connect enrollees to appropriate community resources, such as organizations that provide supplies for newborns and infants.
