

Diabetes Self-Management Education (DSME)

Benefits for Ohio Medicaid Members

All Ohio Medicaid Members are eligible for Diabetes Self-Management Education (DSME) through programs certified by either:

The Association of Diabetes Care & Education Specialists (ADCES)

Or

The American Diabetes Association (ADA)

Members aged 18 to 75 with Diagnosis of Diabetes

Based on Clinician Discretion

Medicaid members are eligible for 10 hours for the first year and 2 hours for follow-up training each year after initial education.
