All Ohio Medicaid Members are eligible for Diabetes Self-Management Education (DSME) through programs certified by either:

The Association of Diabetes Care & Education Specialists (ADCES) The American Diabetes Association (ADA)

> Members aged 18 to 75 with Diagnosis of Diabetes **Based on Clinician Discretion**

Medicaid members are eligible for 10 hours for the first year and 2 hours for follow-up training each year after initial education. **Virtual Options Available**
