Welcome to Humana

Your dental health maintenance organization (DHMO) plan is administered by Humana. We're pleased to team up with ERS to serve plan participants with benefits that make it easy for you to get the dental care you need, when you need it.

The benefits and services highlighted below provide an overview of the dental plan you can sign up for. **The table shows how services will be paid when you visit a dentist in the network. There are no out-of-network benefits.**

HumanaDental DHMO

When you see your participating primary care dentist (PCD), you pay a set amount or copay, for each service. There are no yearly maximums, deductibles or waiting periods. Below is a sampling of the most frequently used dental services.

Frequently asked plan questions:

How do I start using my plan?

After you enroll, you'll receive a welcome letter with your member ID number and how to designate a primary care dentist (PCD). Simply provide your member ID number, along with your name and birth date when you visit your PCD (dependents will use your member ID number and their name and birth date). You don't need an ID card to see your dentist.

Will I get an ID card?

- **Active employees, retirees not eligible for Medicare and their eligible dependents** will not get an ID card in the mail.
- **Medicare-eligible retirees** will get an ID card in the mail, though you don't need an ID card to see your dentist.

What if my PCD doesn't provide the care I need?

You may need to select an in-network specialist, or your PCD can help you find one. If you receive treatment from an in-network specialist (including orthodontia), there are no plan benefits, but you'll receive a 25% cost reduction from the usual fee for covered services.

How to find a PCD in the network

If you enroll in this plan, you must visit a PCD you select to receive dental benefits. Before you enroll, you can search online to find a PCD in the network following these steps:



Step 1	Before Sept. 1, go to your.Humana.com/ERS and select “ Find a dentist ” in the “HumanaDental DHMO” tab
Step 2: Enter search information	Enter your address or ZIP code
Step 3: Search providers	You can search all providers, a dentist’s name or specialty
Step 4: Find a PCD	Choose a dentist from the search results and then take note of their name and location. The dentist you selected will need to be designated as your PCD before you get dental services.

Frequently asked network questions:

What if my dentist isn’t in the network?

If your dentist is not in the network, you’ll need to select a new PCD in the Humana network to receive benefits. You can also refer your dentist to the network by visiting [your.Humana.com/ERS](https://your.humana.com/ERS) and select “**Provider nomination form**” in the “HumanaDental DHMO” tab.

How do I designate a PCD?

After you activate your online MyHumana account and login, follow these steps:

- Go to the “**Care**” tab at the top of the page
- Choose “**Select a dentist**” button
- Then search for a specific dentist or browse the list
- Select a dentist accepting new patients and click the “**Confirm**” button

Does everyone in my family need to go to the same dentist?

No. Each family member on your plan can select their own PCD.

Do I need a referral to see a specialist?

No. You may select your own in-network specialist, or your PCD can help you find one.

Activate your account:

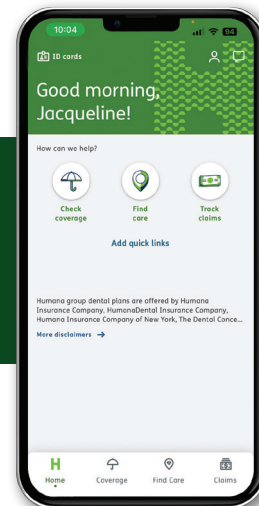
Beginning Aug. 3, go to your.Humana.com/ERS to create an account and get started – all you'll need is your member ID which you'll get on your welcome letter:

- Select **“Sign in to MyHumana”** then **“Create account”**
- Enter the information requested
- On next screen, verify your identity with your mobile number or email address
- For the final step, select **“Humana member ID”** and enter the following:

Submitting a claim

Your dentist will submit your dental claim directly to Humana. However, an out-of-network dentist may require you to pay up front and you'll need to submit a claim for reimbursement.
