



Information about the launch of generic Breo Ellipta

Effective May 28, 2022, generic Breo Ellipta (fluticasone/vilanterol) is not covered or may require prior authorization for CarePlus patients. Brand-name Breo Ellipta will continue to be covered and can be filled for the patients.

Prescriber frequently asked questions on generic Breo Ellipta

1. Q: Is generic Breo Ellipta (fluticasone/vilanterol) being covered at the pharmacy?

A: For CarePlus plans generic Breo Ellipta (fluticasone/vilanterol) is not covered or may require prior authorization. Brand-name Breo Ellipta is covered and can be filled for your patients.

2. Q: Why isn't generic fluticasone furoate/vilanterol covered?

A: CarePlus decided not to cover fluticasone/vilanterol at this time; brand-name Breo Ellipta is on the formulary.

3. Q: Can I request an exception for fluticasone/vilanterol?

A: It is possible, but the cost share for fluticasone/vilanterol may be the same as or higher than brand-name Breo-Ellipta.

4. Q: Will fluticasone/vilanterol be covered in the future?

A: CarePlus may cover fluticasone/vilanterol at some point in the future.
