

# Standard Acquisition Charges (SAC) for organ acquisition

This internal FAQ documents aims to help frontline associates answer providers' questions about organ acquisition services and how to submit their Standard Acquisition Charge (SAC) rates.

## What happens if the provider fails to submit by the deadline?

TRICARE will use the hospital's overall operation cost-to-charge ratio to reduce charges.

## What are the revenue codes?

The revenue codes are 0811 (acquisition of body components, live donor) and 0812 (acquisition of body components, cadaver donor).

## Does the provider need to submit with S2152?

No, DHA confirmed that S2152 is not required. It is in the reimbursement policy, however HCPCS is only added for the TRICARE Encounter Data (TED) on the backend.

## Is there a required format or form to use?

Yes. Find the form at [SAC form for organ acquisition](#).

## Can I submit it now?

Yes, you can submit any time before August of the current year.

## Can D4 worksheets be submitted?

No, per policy we have to survey providers for SAC rates and cadaver/live organ only. We cannot accept any D4 work sheets.

Any rates received after August 30th of that year will be held until the next year.
